PROCEDURE TO MAKE KRISHI CARD

Farmer has to apply for Krishi Card in prescribed format along with following documents placed in file with Annexures of land details duly signed.

- a. Self attested copy of all Form I & XIV of land parcels wherein farmer intends to take various benefits/schemes.
- b. No objection certificate/self declaration of co-occupants/co-tenants as the case may be.
- c. Affidavit of applicant with declaration of his share ownership/title as the case may be.
- d. Passport size Photograph of applicant.
- e. Self attested copy of Adhar Card, Election Card, Ration Card, Bank Passbook/Mandate Form Xerox.
- f. Self attested copy of Aadhar Card, Election Card, Bank passbook Xerox of Nominee of applicant.
- g. Certificate of caste issued by Competent Authority in case of SC/ST Farmers.

Submit all the documents at the Zonal Agriculture office wherein your agriculture land is located.

1. FERTILIZER CONTROL ORDER 1985 (by online mode only)

Fertilizer Control Order 1985: Registrations certificate/letter of Authorization for Retail/Wholesale Fertilizer dealers are issued under clause 7 of Fertilizer Control Order (FCO) 1985.

I. Registration of New Dealers:

Procedure & format to obtain Letter of Authorization (LOA).

Documents/Forms required for application:

- a) Certificate of source of supply fertilizer under Form "O"
- b) Site Plan/Sketch showing sale point/storage point.
- c) Recommendations of Fertilizer Inspector
- d) Fee of `600/- for wholesale LOA and dealer and `300/- for Retail LOA dealer and the acknowledgement will be valid for a period of 3 years and issued in Form A2.

II. Renewal of registration certificate/Letter of Authorization (LOA): (by online mode only)

Documents required:-

- a) Certificate of source of supply of fertilizer under Form "O".
- b) Original Certificate/Letter of Authorization.
- c) Recommendation of Fertilizer Inspector.
- d) Renewal fee of Rs.400/- for wholesale and Rs.200/- for retailer. Late fee of Rs.200/- and Rs.75/- wholesaler and retailer is applicable respectively if the application is submitted within one month of expiry date. The renewed LOA will be valid for further period of 3 years.

III. Amendments to LOA: (by online mode only)

- a) Application on plain paper.
- b) Certificate of source of supply in Form "O".
- c) Original Letter of Authorization.
- d) Amendment fee of Rs.30/- per product for wholesale and Rs.20/- per product for retailer after due recommendation of fertilizer Inspector.

IV. Duplicate/Additional copy of certificate: (by online mode only)

- a) Application on plain paper
- b) Fee of Rs.50/- for wholesaler and Rs.20/- for retailer.

V. Organic fertilizers like city compost, organic manure, Vermi compost and Bio fertilizers like Rhizobium, Azatobacter, Acetobacter and Azospirillum are brought under the perview of FCO 1985.

Manufacture and sale of above organic manure and Bio-fertilizers require Registration Certificate/Letter of Authorization from Directorate of Agriculture

Procedure to obtain a certificate of manufacture of bio fertilizers/organic fertilizer:

1. Site Plan/Sketch showing Manufacturing Unit/Storage point.
2. List of Laboratory facilities available
3. Name and address of Compliance Officer designated for FCO purposes.
4. Analysis report of the product.
5. Inspection report of fertilizer inspector
6. NOC of Pollution Control Board, Factories and Boilers.
7. Bagging and packing details.

INSECTICIDE ACT, 1968:

Implementation of the insecticide Act, 1968

I. Issue of manufacturing license: (by online mode only)

Any manufacturer of insecticide or obtaining desiring to do so after registration certificate for the manufactured from products desired to be Board Central Insecticide Committee (CIB & RC) Faridabad. and Registration,

Procedure & format to obtain certificate/license:

- a) Apply in Form V for grant of license giving details of registration of insecticides to be manufactured, name(s) of expert persons, safety provision etc.
- b) Payment of a fee of Rs.2000/- for each insecticide to be manufactured subject to a maximum of Rs.20,000/- for each place of manufacture.

II. Issue of license to sell, stock, or exhibit for sale or distribute insecticides: (by online mode only)

Any person desirous of trading in pesticides/dealers of pesticides.

Procedure & format to obtain certificate/license:

- a) Apply in Form VII for license.
- b) Furnish valid principal certificate (from manufacturer)
- c) Payment of a fee of Rs. 20,000/- per insecticide subject to a maximum of Rs.7500/- for each place of stocking/sale etc.

III. Issue of License for grant of License/Renewal of License to stock and use of Insecticide for commercial Pest Control Operation:

- a) Apply in Form VII for new license and renewal.
- b) Furnish valid Principal Certificate from manufacturers.
- c) Payment of fee of `1000/-, the license is valid for 3 calendar years.

III. Phytosanitary Certificate:
