- 2) The candidates should be resident of Goa for minimum period of 15 years.
- 3) The selection will be based on merit and weightage as below and shall be provisional:

- The selection of candidate for B.Tech(Agril. Enng) shall be made under Common Admission Procedure of the Directorate of Technical Education, Alto Porvorim, Goa
- 4) Non- Creamy layer certificate in case of O.B.C. candidates should be attached.
 - 5) **There will be no hostel facilities presently available with the college. The selected candidates will have to make his/her own arrangements for stay at the institution of studies.**
 - 6) The selected candidates should make their own arrangements for travel from Goa to the college of studies.
 - 7) The candidate should attach the attested photocopies of the marks list of XIIth Science, school leaving certificate, the residential certificate, birth certificate, Adhar card and other certificates as applicable.
 - 8) The list of the eligible candidates as per the merit will be displayed on the Departmental notice board, which may be verified by applicant. Selected candidate will also be informed by ordinary post. However Department will not be responsible for delay or non receipt of such letter.
 - 9) The candidates shall produce the original certificates when demanded.
 - 10) The selected candidates will have to convey his/her acceptance of the selection on or before the last day indicated on the notice of the merit list.
 - 11) The selected candidate will pay all his tuition fees, hostel fees, and deposits as applicable to the students on his/her own after the final selection and admission of the College.

- 12) The selected candidate will have to furnish a security of `2,000/- to this Directorate in form of Demand Draft drawn on any Nationalized Bank payable at Panaji in the name of Director of Agriculture, Caranzalem to affirm his/her candidature at the time of acceptance.
- 13) The security deposit of the candidates will be forfeited in favour of the Government for his/her failure to report to the college within the stipulated time or for abandoning the study in the middle of year.
- 14) The security deposit will be refunded to the applicant after successful completion of the studies duly supported by a letter from the college of studies to that effect.
- 15) The candidates will be required to undergo medical fitness test as directed by the college of studies.
- 16) The selected candidates will have to abide to all the terms and conditions of admission, study, behavior, discipline, etc., as specified from time to time by the college and the Directorate of Agriculture, Goa. The selected candidates will have to execute bond on `50/- non-judicial stamp paper affirming to adhere to these conditions.
- 17) The students interested in seeking admission for B.Sc(Agri)/B.Sc(Hort) should apply to Directorate of Agriculture, Krishi Bhavan, Tonca, Caranzalem, Goa
- 18) The students interested in seeking admission for B.Tech. (Agril. Engg.) should apply to Directorate of Technical Education, Porvorim
- 19) The last date for submission of completed application form is **19/09/2017**
- 20) The provisional merit list of candidates will be displayed on notice board on **20/09/2017** at 10.00 a.m. and objection or correction, if any is to be intimated in writing by 4.00 p.m.on same day
- 21) Due to Paucity of time, list of selected candidates will be displayed/announced, discipline- wise on **21/09/2017** at 10.00 a.m and conveyance of acceptance by 4.00 p.m on same day. If acceptance from any of the selected candidate not received with in stipulated time, offer to next reserve candidate will be consider.
- 22) After completion of admission formalities the students should immediately submit a copy of admission fee receipt to this Directorate, for release of stipend.
- 23) Due to commencement of classes from last week of August 2017, considering the late admissions students will be required to updates and make up the missed syllabus
