VALUE ADDED MANGO PRODUCTS COMPETITION

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Any individual can participate in the competition
2. The competition will be held for the following 7 categories:
(i) Pickle (sweet) (ii) Pickle (spicy) (iii) Jam (iv) Squash/ Juice/ Syrup/Panhe (v) Chutneys (vi) Dessert (vii) Leather.
3. The product should be advanced prepared/ pre - cooked.
4. The finished product should be minimum of 200 grams./200 ml.
5. The recipe of the product should be submitted along with the product at the time of entry.
6. The entries should reach the venue on 17th May 2024 between 9.30 A.M. to 11.00A.M. or at any Zonal Agricultural Office on 16th May, 2024 before 5.00 p.m.
7. Each entry should be accompanied with a prescribed entry form duly filled in.
8. The organizers reserve the right to remove the product if deterioration has taken place beyond the acceptable standard.
9. Judging will be done on following criteria:
 - (i) Composition – 10 points
 - (ii) Taste, Texture & Consistency – 20 points
 - (iii) Presentation & Portion size – 20 points
10. No entry fee will be charged.
11. Cash Prizes and Certificates will be awarded for the first best three entries in each category.
(1st Prize-Rs. 3000/-, 2nd Prize-Rs. 2000/-, 3rd Prize-Rs. 1000/-)
12. Certificate of participation will be given to all the participants.
13. If the number of entries is less than 5 in any category then only two prizes will be awarded and if the number of entries is less than 3 in any category, only one prize will be awarded.
14. The organizers reserve the right to use recipes and photographs taken in any publications and reproduction.
15. The decision of the organizing committee/ judging committee will be final and binding on all the participants.
16. The organizers reserve the right to rescind, modify or add on to any of the above rules and conditions and their interpretation is final. The organizers reserve the right to limit the number of entries per category / cancel the category, if need arises.

MANGO FRUIT COMPETITION

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Any farmer/ Individual/ Institute having mango trees grown in the state of Goa can participate in the competition.
2. Government farm, Government Institutions cannot participate in the competition however a pavilion specially designed wherein they can exhibit their products/ fruits.
3. The property at which the mango tree is grown need not necessarily be in the name of the contestant.
4. The competition will be held for following categories.
 - A) **Goan Varieties** - (9 categories)
(i) Malcorado (ii) Mossurad (Salcette) (iii) Mossurad (Bardez) (iv) Hilario
(v) Colaco (vi) Fernandin (vii) Xavier (viii) Furtado (ix) Alphonso
 - B) **Other Goan Varieties** – Other than mentioned in category (A) (One General Category)
 - C) **Hybrid Varieties** – (4 Categories)
(i) Mallika (ii) Ratna (iii) Amrapalli (iv) Sindhu
 - D) **Sucking Type (Ghontam)** – (1 General Category)
 - E) **Exotic Varieties** – (1 General Category)
 - F) **Other Indian Varieties** – (4 Categories)
(i) Totapuri (ii) Kesar (iii) Neelam (iv) General Category (other than mentioned)
5. Each entry should have 3 fully matured mangoes, two of which should compulsorily be fully ripe.
6. Each entry should be accompanied with a prescribed entry form duly filled in.
7. Participants can submit any number of entries.
8. No entry fee will be charged.
9. Cash prizes and Certificates will be awarded for the first three best entries in each category.
(1st Prize-Rs. 3000/-, 2nd Prize-Rs. 2000/-, 3rd Prize-Rs. 1000/-)
10. Certificate of participation will be given to all the participants.
11. If the number of entries is less than 5 in any category then only two prizes will be awarded and if the number of entries is less than 3 in any category, only one prize will be awarded.
12. The entries should be submitted to any Zonal Agricultural Office on 16th May 2024 before 5:00PM or can be submitted directly at the venue on 17th May 2024 before 10:30 am.
13. The organizers shall not take any responsibility towards damage of fruits during transporting and handling
14. The decision of the organizing committee/ judging committee will be final and binding on all the participants.
15. The organizers reserve the right to rescind, modify or add on to any of the above rules and conditions and their interpretation is final. The organizers reserve the right to cancel the category if need arises.
